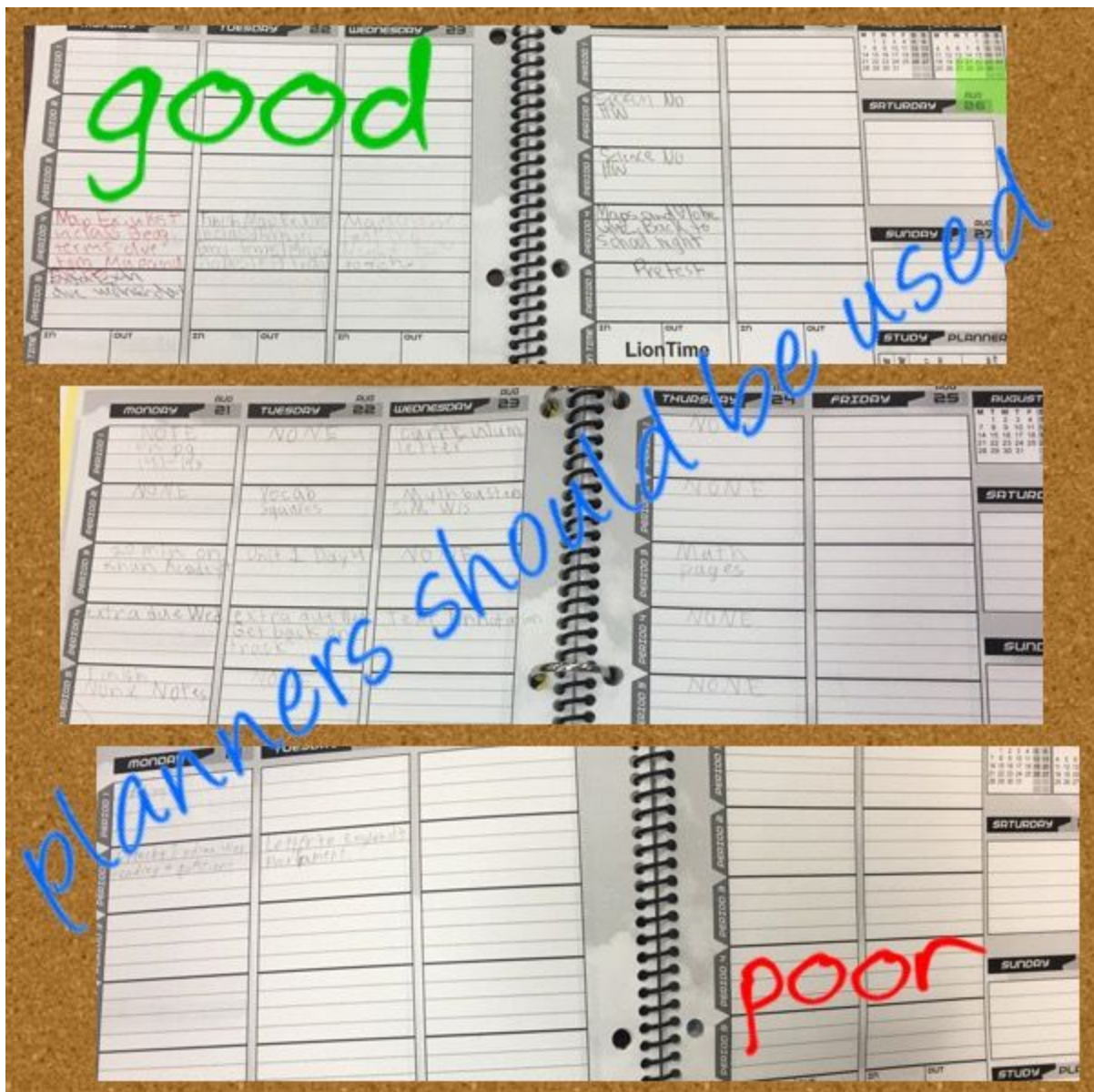

Our campus was covered with community---it looks best that way! Thank you for all who came out and met our teachers and got to know more about our school. Here are some pictures from the night in case you missed it!

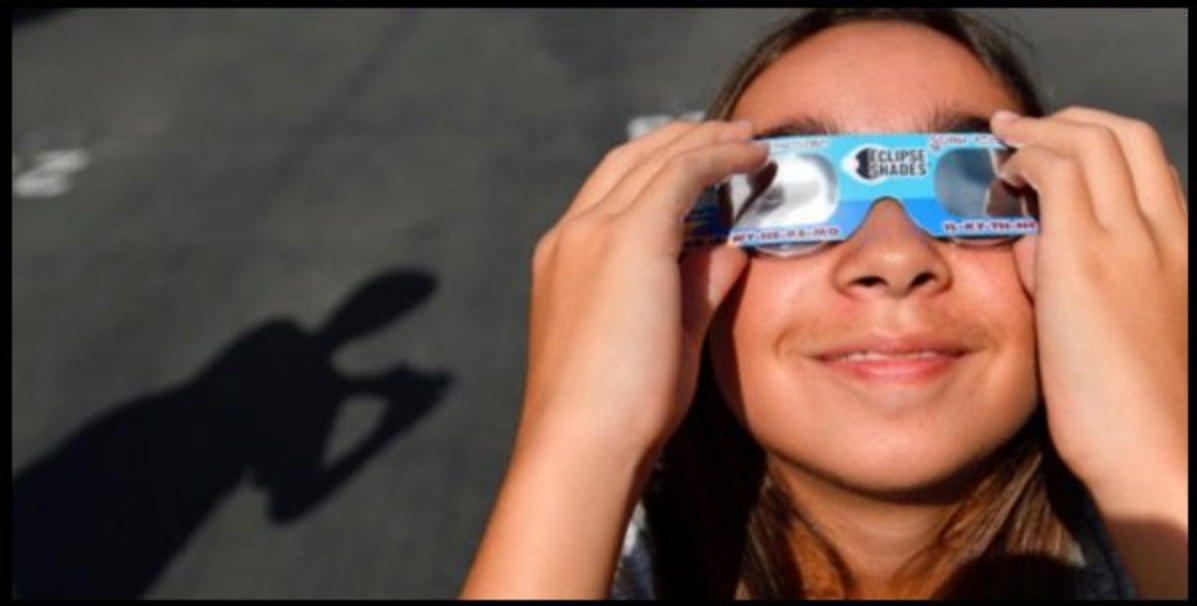




SOLAR ECLIPSE

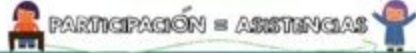

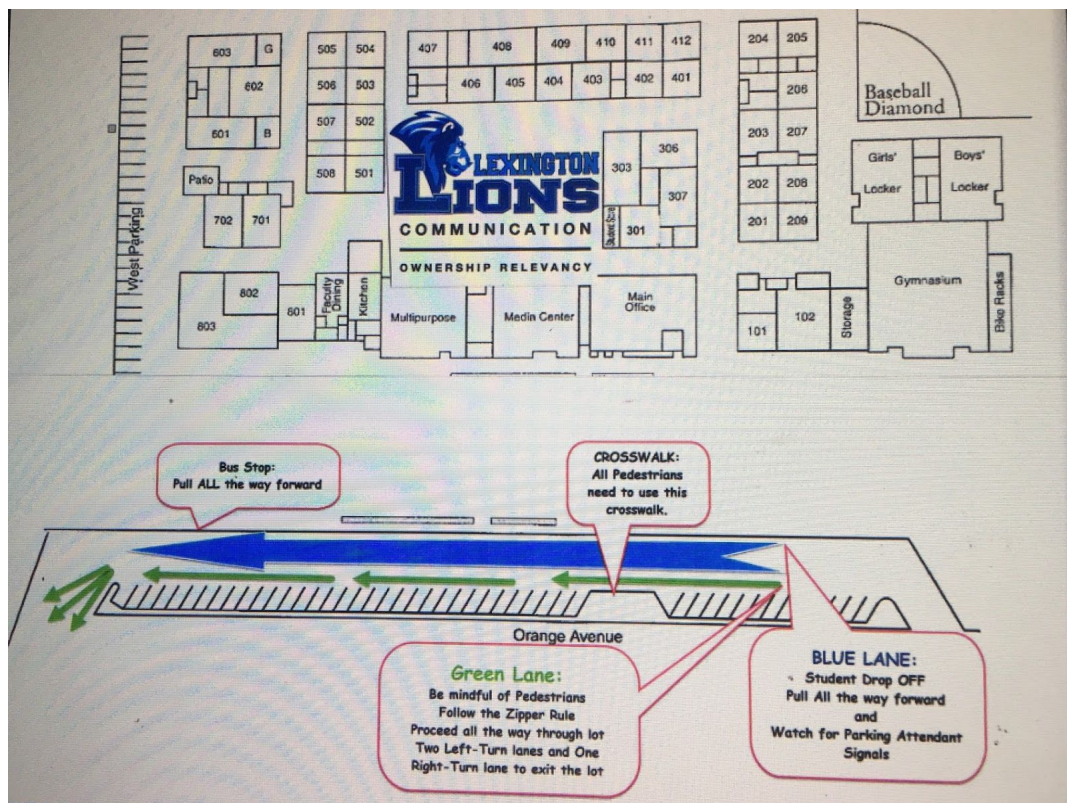


- Need a quiet place to study?


- There are two lanes that enter our parking lot from two directions on Orange Avenue.

- Step 3: Attach a copy of your most recent Report Card (quarter or semester)

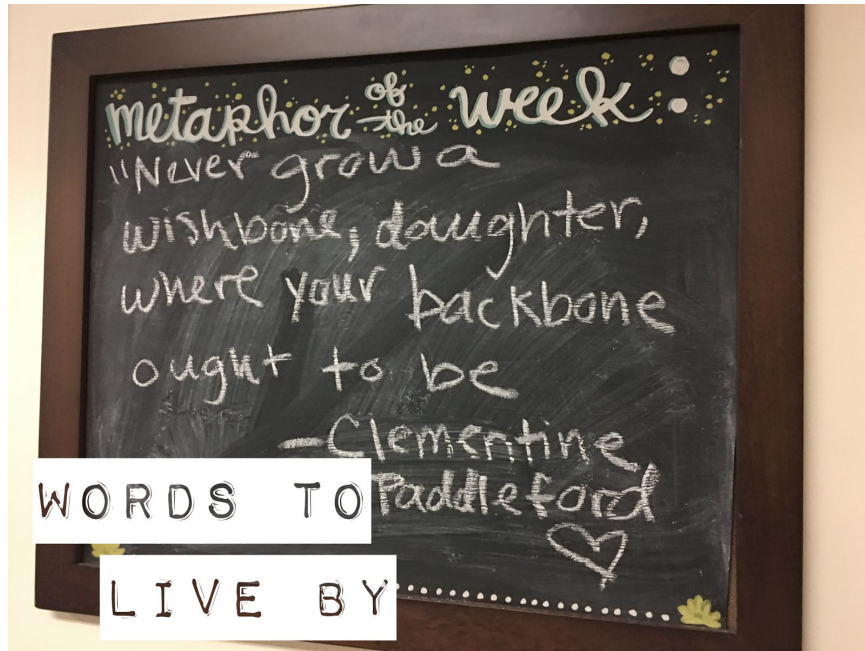
