WORDS OUT LOUD

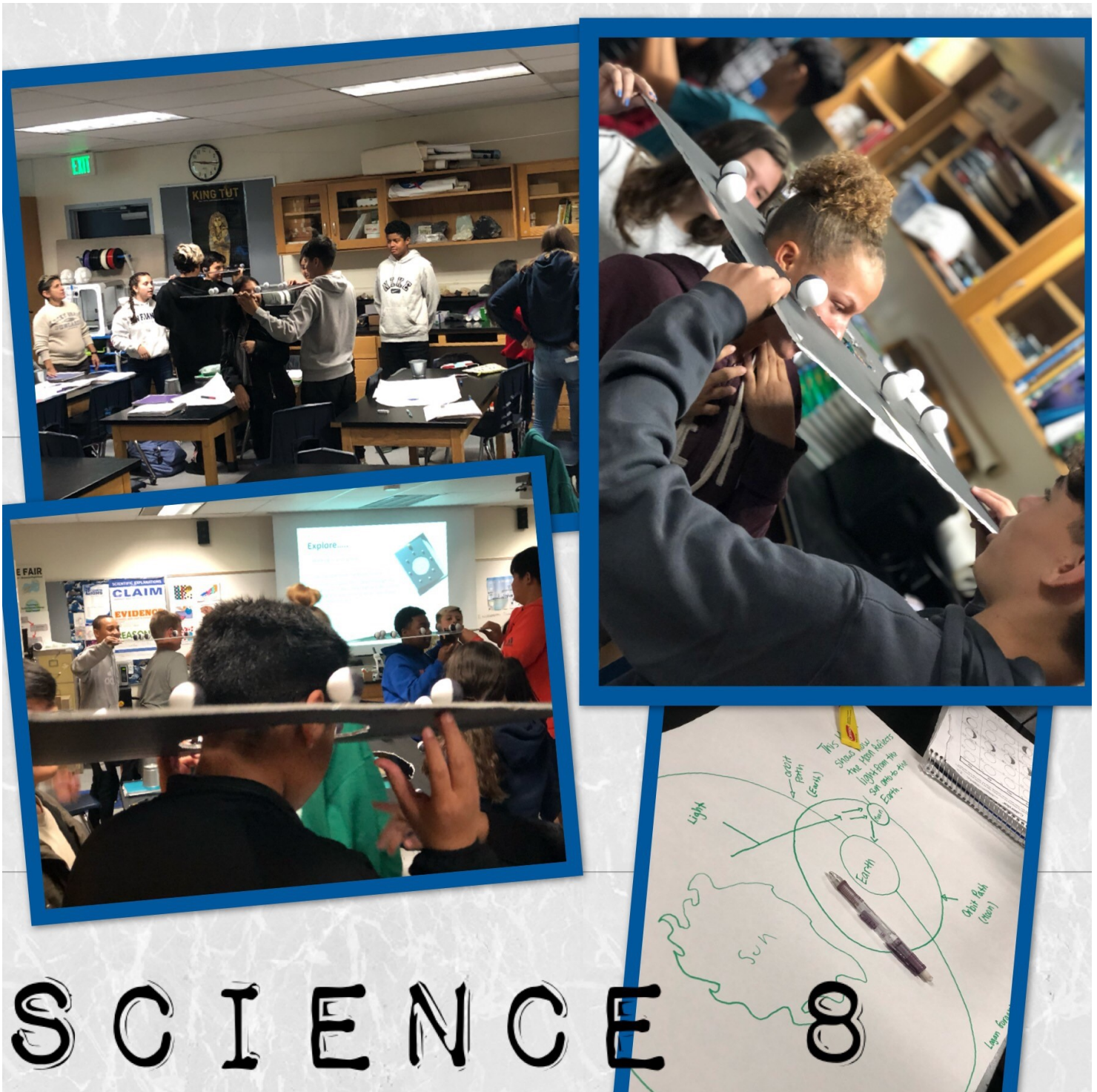

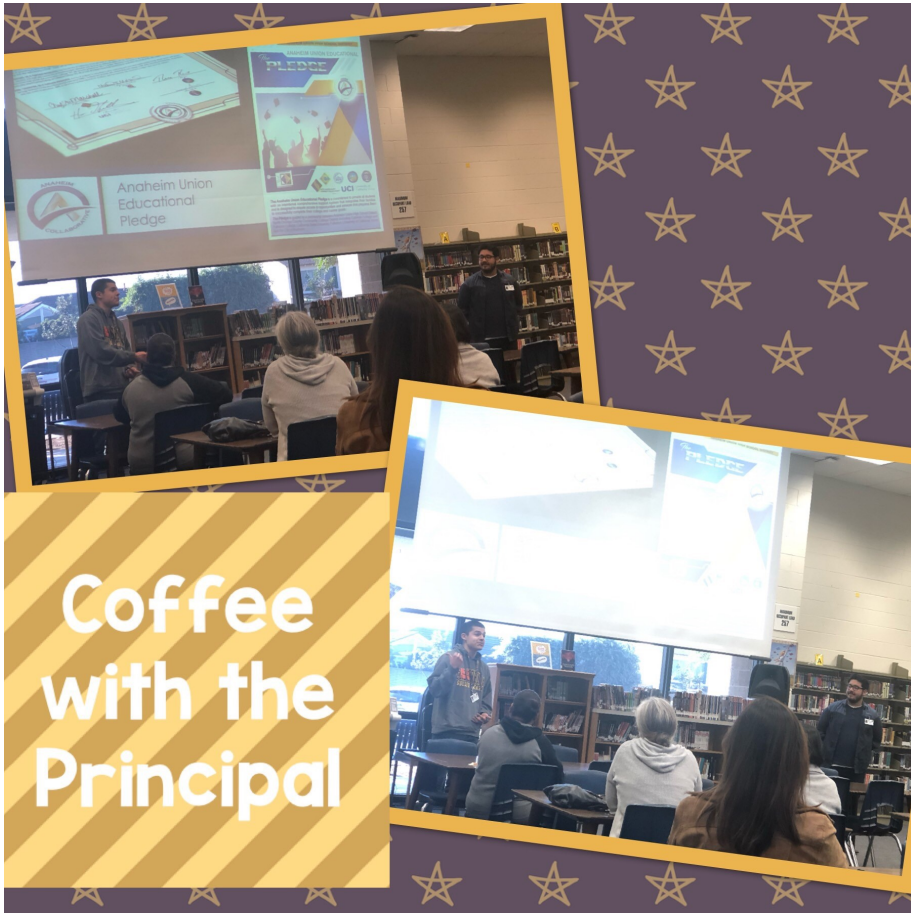

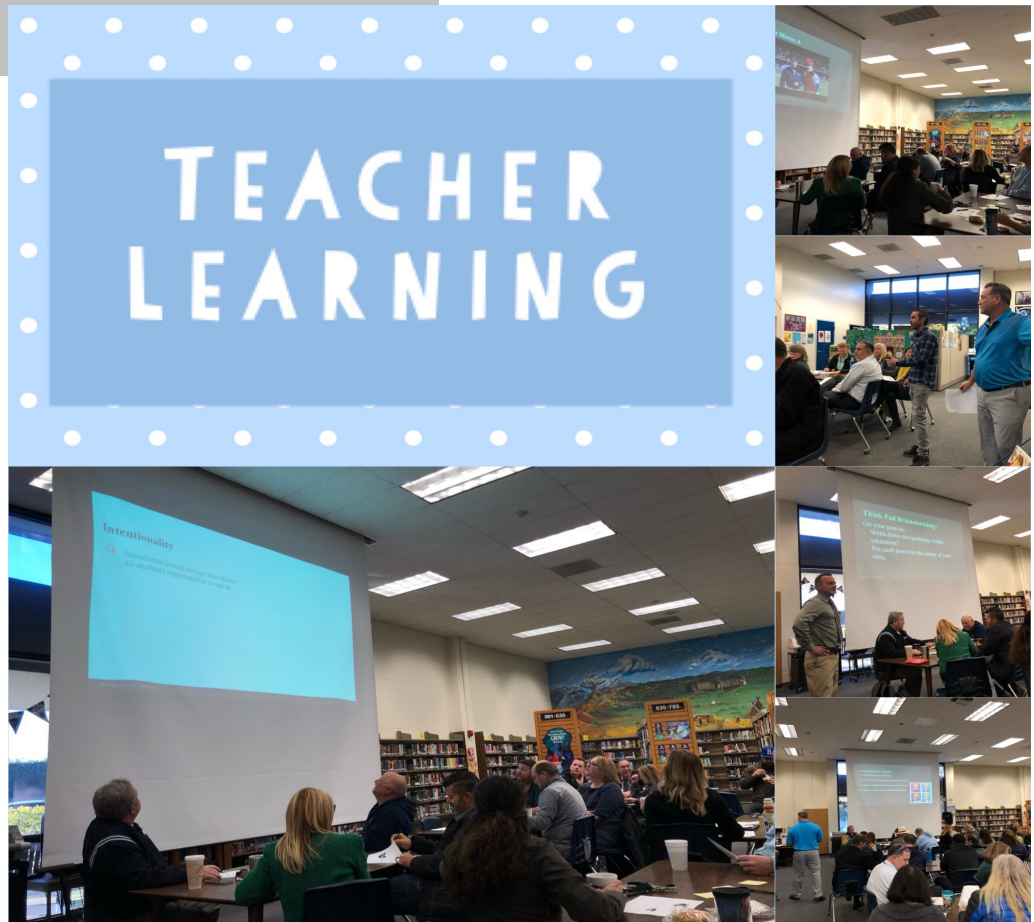


PHOTO GETS GIFTY

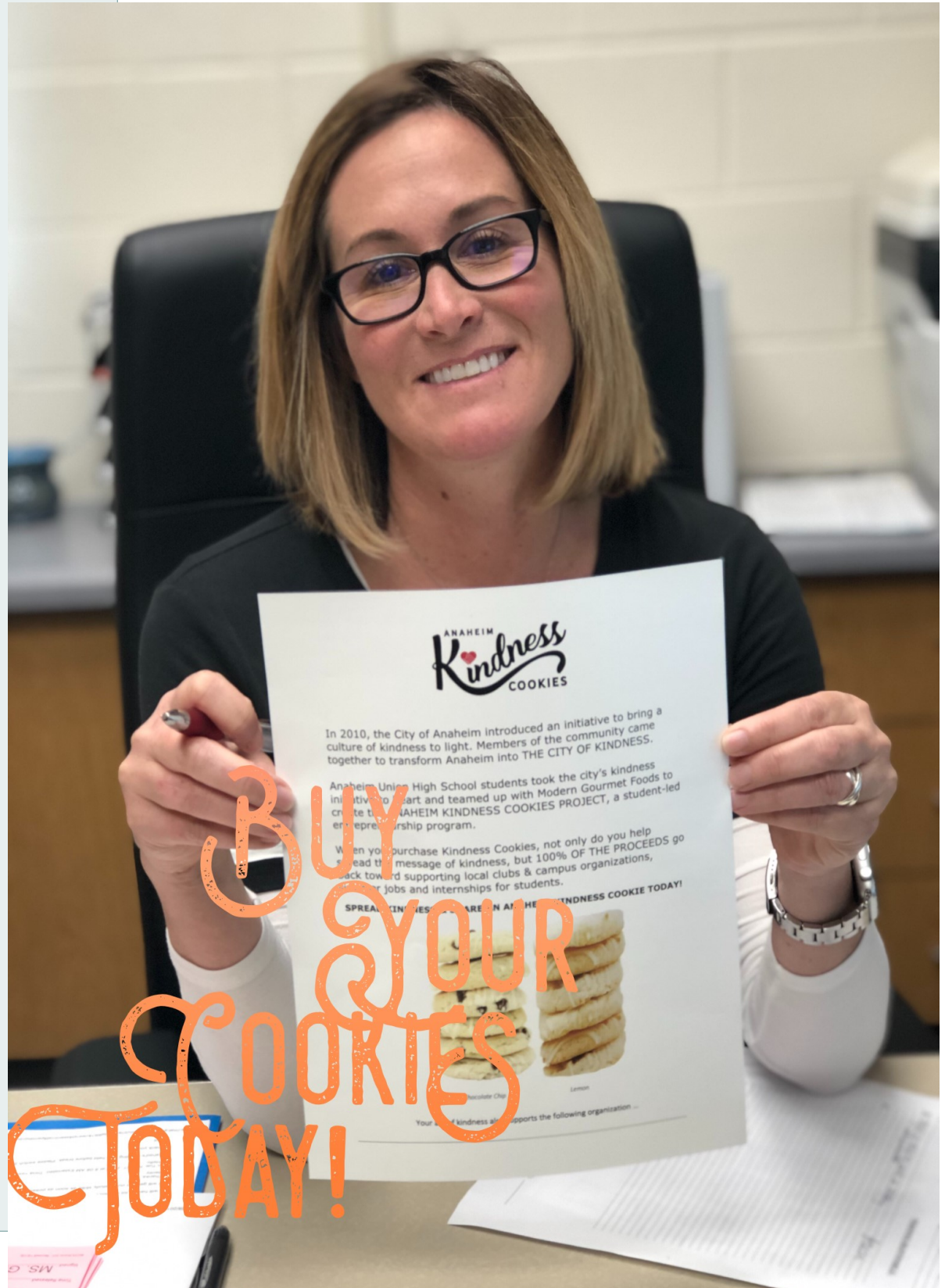
Home Ec Etiquette
