

Lexington does have a unified remote learning schedule that I publicized for your last week and I have also included it below again. Things to remember: All teachers are on Schoology. Mandatory “virtual real time” class meetings are on this schedule below. Our “live/synchronous” student mandatory meetings (which may not be face to face, but real time communication) with classes will only be on Mondays (Periods 1,3,5,7/ODD) and Tuesdays (2,4,6/EVEN). Wednesday, Thursday and Fridays will be “independent/asynchronous” time for students to work on things with optional teacher office hours as specified by each teacher on their Schoology Accounts. Make sure to check out each teacher’s Schoology for systems and assistance. Email teachers with any questions.

We do understand that since our campuses are closed the remainder of this school year, students have questions about how to return library or textbooks, getting items from PE lockers, getting the yearbook, returning tech and probably many more. We are working with AUHSD district to have a unified message and retrieval day for all of these things. This information should be coming out to you in the next couple of weeks.

REMOTE LEARNING SCHEDULE

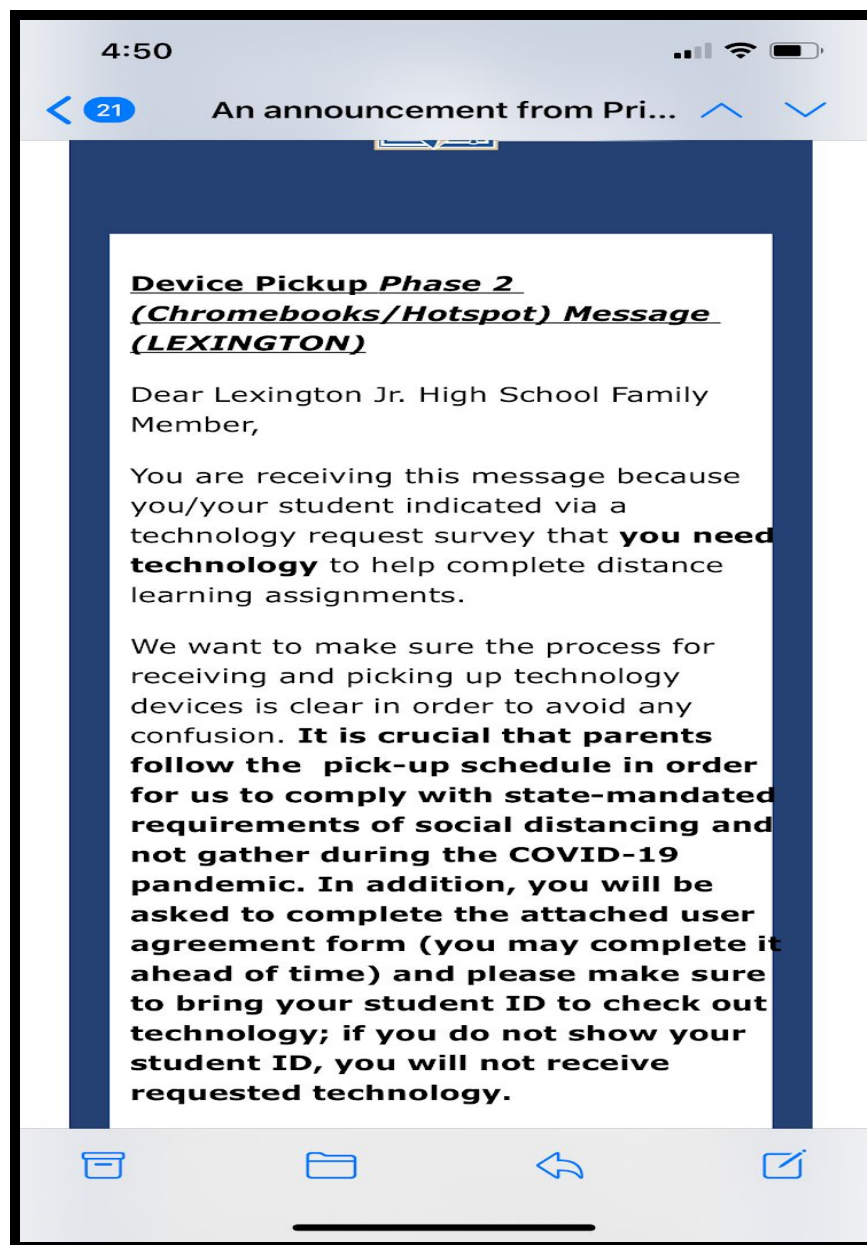

anaheimunion In recent weeks, the State of California escalated its efforts to slow the spread of COVID-19, through the executive order issued by Governor Gavin Newsom calling for California residents to stay at home, with exceptions for attending to essential needs. In addition, a Major Disaster Declaration by President Trump also acknowledged the scope of this crisis and bolstered California's emergency response efforts.

Based on these conditions, directives and preventive measures, the Anaheim Union High School District has extended the dismissal of our schools through the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year, which ends on May 21, 2020.

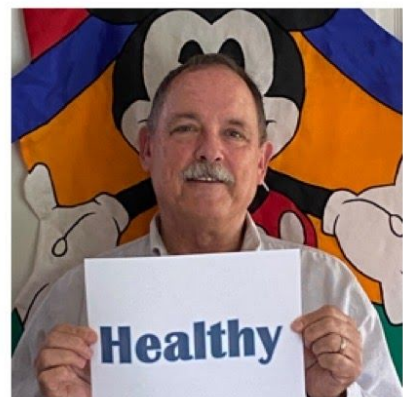
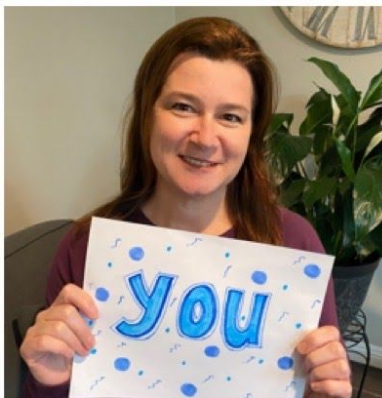
