

Hello Lexington students and families,

I hope this letter this week finds you and your family well. There has been a lot of information on the news lately surrounding education and how schools are planning on opening up this year. This is profoundly important and I wanted to make sure that you are aware of the impact for you and your child. Our first and most important priority is to ensure the safety of all of our students and our teachers and staff. With that in mind, the Anaheim Union High School District Board of Trustees, Thursday July 16th, voted to begin the school year via distance learning. So, what does this mean for our Lions?

- **Ensuring safety for our students and staff:** Long Distance Learning schedule will include multiple days of synchronous (live on-line classes) and asynchronous learning to engage students every day.
- **Teachers are well-prepared:** There has been on-going training throughout this summer and into next year for our teachers in the National Online Teaching Standards, crosswalked to the California Standards for the Teaching Profession (CSTP), which focus on student engagement, teacher presence, and rigorous project based learning through the 5Cs - collaboration, creativity, communication, critical thinking, and compassion.
- **Continued strong Academics** – Students will continue to get strong and creative academic instruction through our Schoology platform.
- **Supporting students' social/emotional wellbeing** – Continuing work with counselors and social worker to address needs, provide resources and support students during distance learning.
- **Setting up students for success** – Family and student engagement / orientation nights for Q&A, tutorials are being planned. Textbook and technology distribution so all students have access to materials.

Even though this is not how we wanted to start the year or envisioned our children's journey in junior high school, we are in this together, and we will rise above together. *"Nine-tenths of education is encouragement"* - Anatole France.

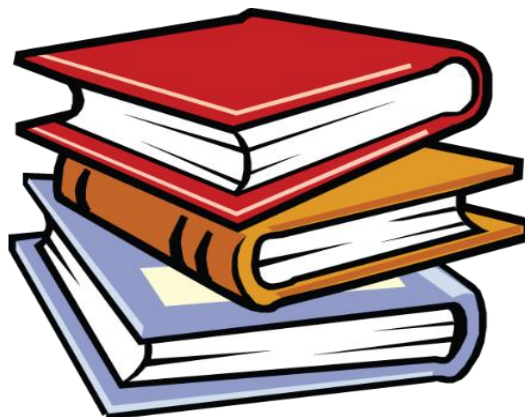
Please follow the schedule below if you need to take care of any of these items.

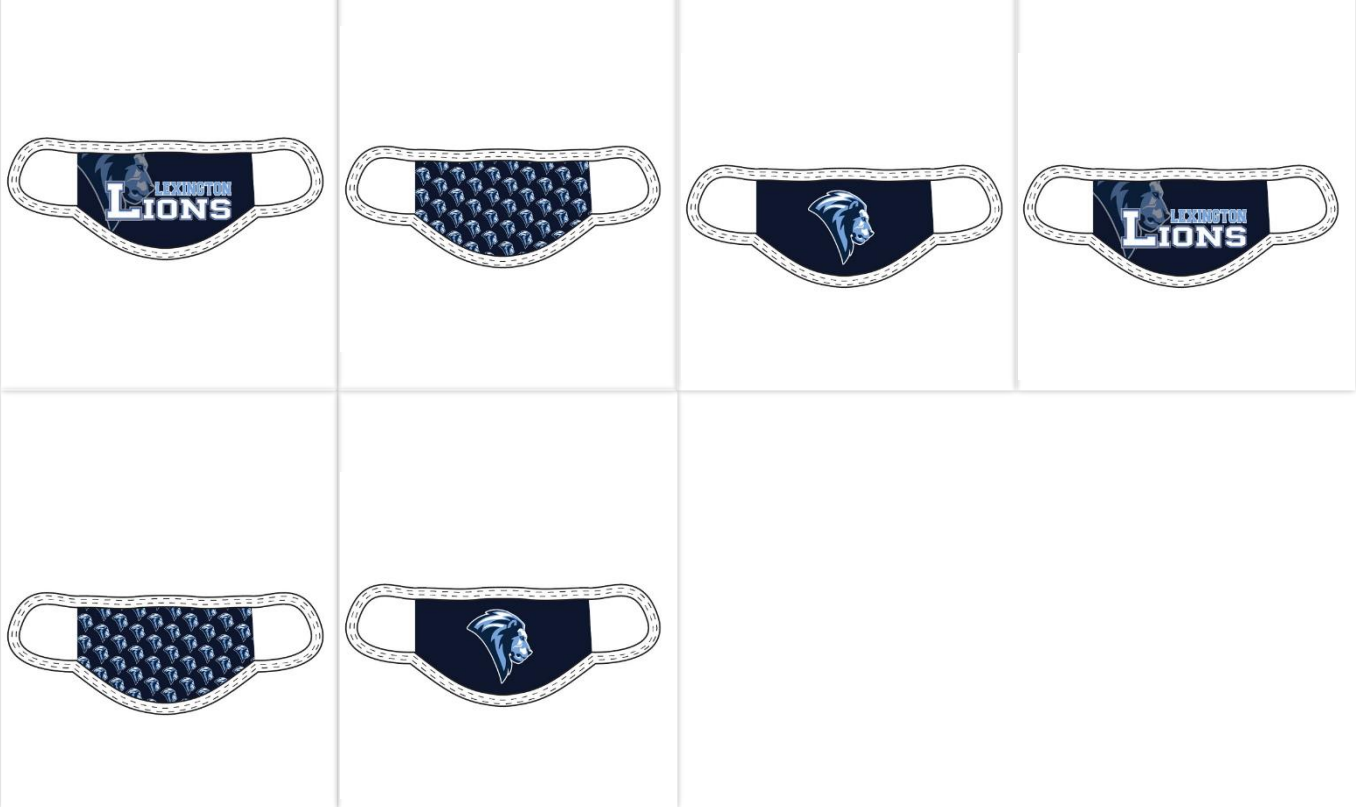
