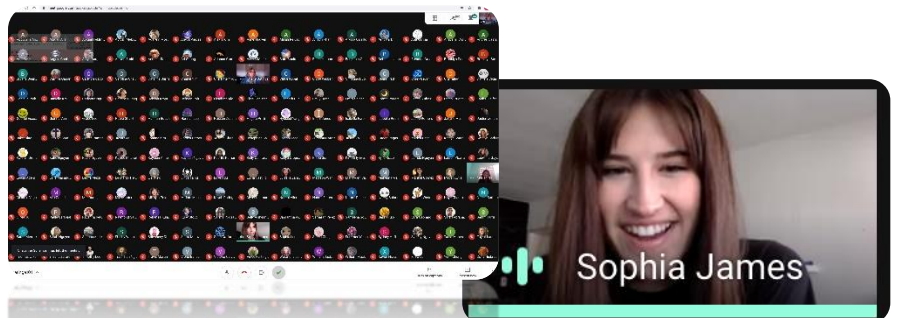
Lex-Technology Student Support



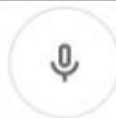
