

Hello Lexington students and families,

As we start week three of 2^{nd} quarter, I wanted to touch upon a couple of updates that you need to be aware of. We are implementing two important changes:

- 1. Virtual learning schedule revision Starting Monday, November 2nd, all Monday, Wednesday, and Friday synchronous classes will increase by five minutes. This means that we will have 40-minute periods on those days. All classes will start at the same time. The additional time will be added to the end of the period. This will also change the passing period from 15 minutes to 10 minutes. There is no change to the Tuesday and Thursday asynchronous days. Please see attached pages for the revised schedule.
- 2. New T/TH (asynchronous) attendance process will go live tomorrow, Tuesday, 10/27. We are eliminating the attendance check-in assignment for each class and putting in place a simple two step process:
 - a. Attendance for Period 2 Students will still continue to check in live to their 2^{nd} period class
 - b. Attendance for Periods 1,3,4,5,6,7 During 2nd period, teachers will post an attendance Google Form in the Schoology discussion chat. Students will fill out a simple attendance form that will take student attendance for the remaining periods 1,3,4,5,6,7.

A new form goes live every Tuesday / Thursday during 2^{nd} period and will close at 2:00pm that day. If for some reason students miss 2^{nd} period, they can find the live form posted in the Attendance for T/TH course on their Schoology Dashboard. This form will only be used to take attendance for periods 1,3,4,5,6,7. **Teachers will walk students through the process tomorrow.**

Please remember, students still need to check-in to their periods on Schoology every Tuesday/Thursday to engage in the work that has been assigned for that class. Filling out the attendance form only takes attendance and does not count for work turned in or engagement in the class. Below is a sample of what the form will look like.

Next week is Red Ribbon week - don't forget to wear red on Wednesday and Thursday, we will be having a student drive-thru trick or treat from 10-12pm. Be on the lookout for more details during the ASB announcements. Remember, you can find all of our activities under the Activities Icon on the Lexington Website.




Chat with Mr. Klatzker


