Offered tuition-free by the 100 Black Men of Orange County, sessions are held every other Saturday throughout the school year, the Passport Program seeks to assist the transition of these students from adolescent boys to confident young men ready to successfully take on the challenges of college, career and community.

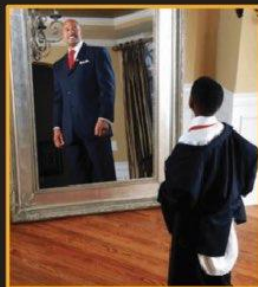

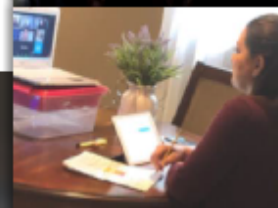
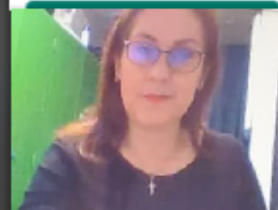
