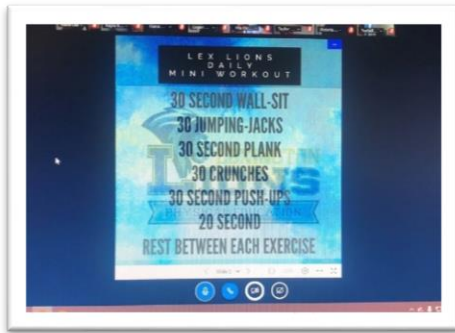


Hello Lions,

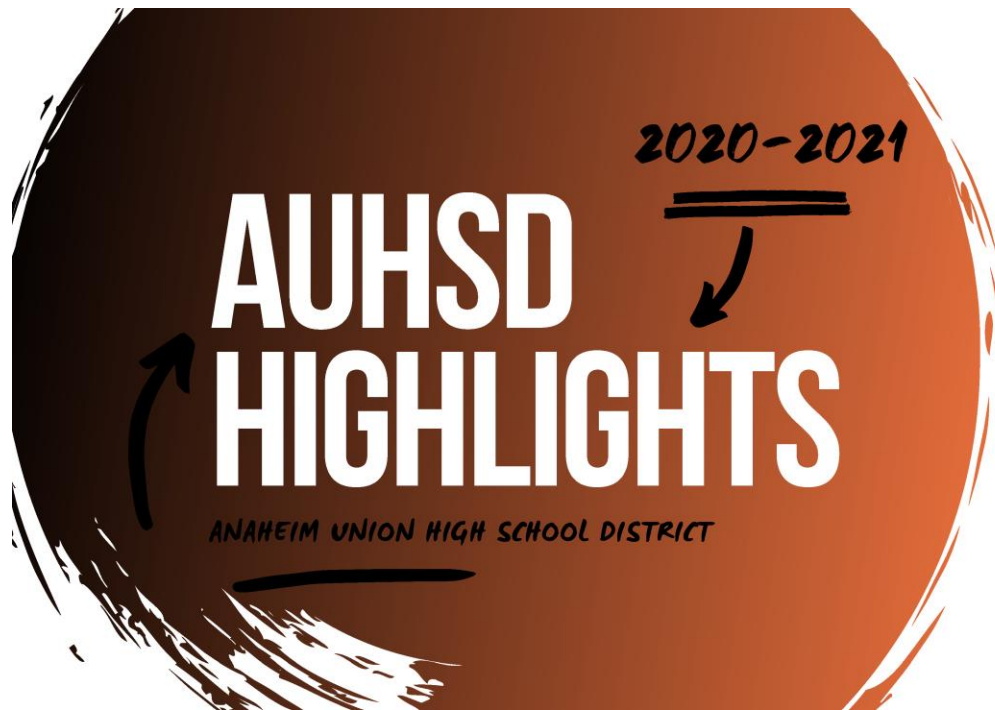

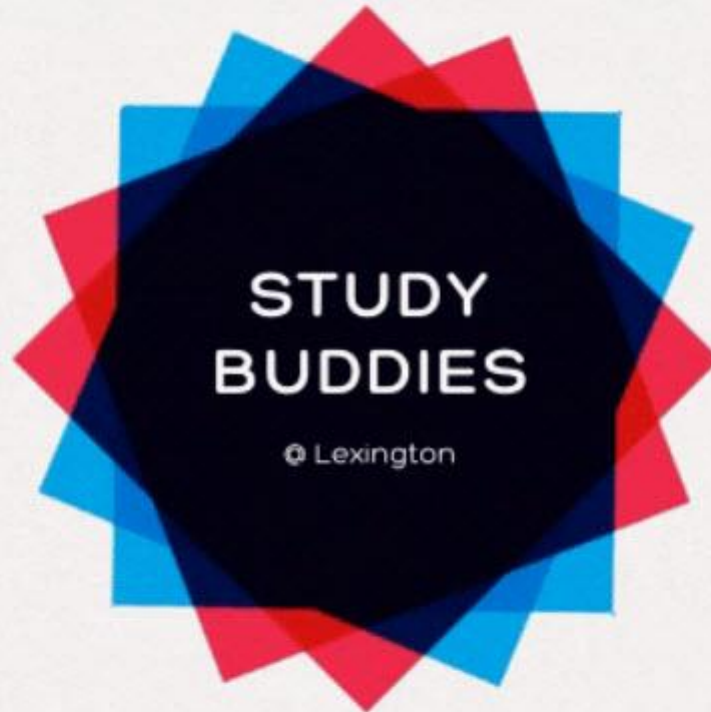
