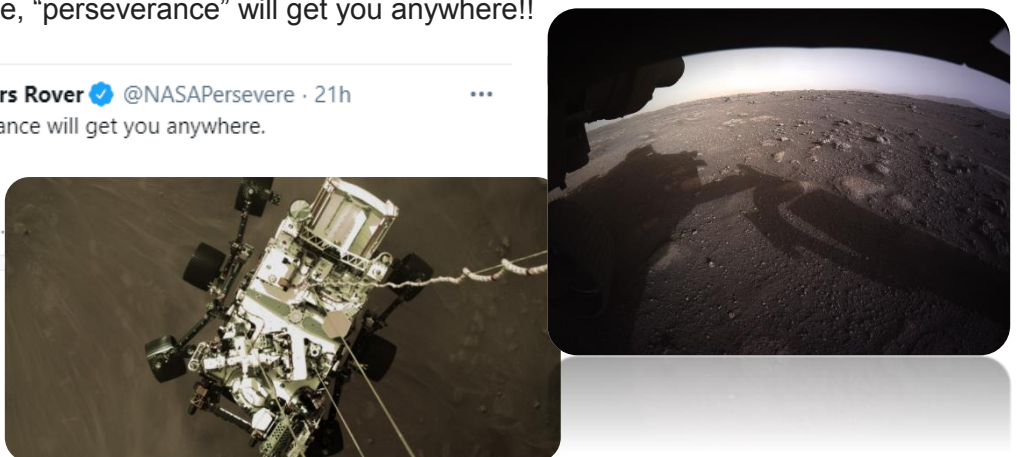

9th GRADE REGISTRATION FAQ

AERIES-

Why won't it let me register for classes in Aeries? *It says "Course requests can not be entered currently"*

- Please check the drop down arrow on the right, next to your name. Make sure you choose the correct school level "Cypress High School." *or whatever High School is listed (you will have the opportunity to pick classes again if you plan on transferring schools)

Can I change my course selections in Aeries?

- Yes, you can change your course selections in Aeries before the due date of February 26th.

How do I input classes in Aeries?

Classes- 6 periods

What classes need to be input into aeries?

- You need to input 6 classes: 1. English 2. Math 3. Science 4. Health-Intro digital art or Health-Career, Finance, Technology 5. PE 6. Elective class *plus 2+ alternates for your electives
- This is due **February 26th.**

Can freshmen take 0 period?

- No. This is only available to upperclassmen starting sophomore year.

World Language

If I am in Spanish 1 this year, what level of spanish will I take next year?

- You need a C or better and 2.5 minimum to take Spanish 2.
- Check with your world language teacher to see if you are ready to take the next level.

History/ Social Science

Do I need to register for a social science or history class next year?

- No, 9th graders are not required to take history or social science. You will meet the 3 year requirement in your Sophomore, Junior, and Senior years.

PE and Athletics

If I plan on doing a sport or joining an athletic team will this count for my PE class?

- No, sign up for PE 1 (PE100). Tryouts will be held next year. Schedule changes will happen after tryouts are done.
