Updated Covid Vaccine Sites

Anaheim provides easy access to vaccines at City Hall, Brookhurst Community Center and through clinics in our neighborhoods.

The Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccines are available to people 18 years and older.

The Pfizer vaccine is available to people 12 years and older.

Kids aged 12-17 must have a parent or guardian accompany them to get the vaccine. Proof of birth date is also required.
