Technology Requirements:

To participate in virtual classes, each registered student will need a computer or device with internet connection. The Zoom video conferencing platform will be used to conduct the class, and should be downloaded prior to the class. It is also highly recommended that students have a webcam and microphone so that s/he can be active participants in the class. Some classes may require a tablet/cell phone to participate in certain activities.

Once a student has registered, a separate email will be sent with safety and security guidelines in addition to a link to access the class via Zoom a week before the session begins.
