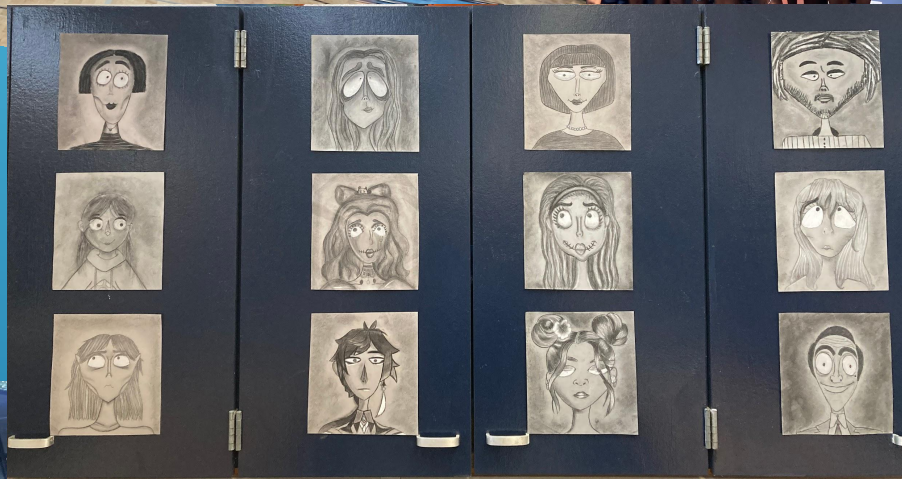
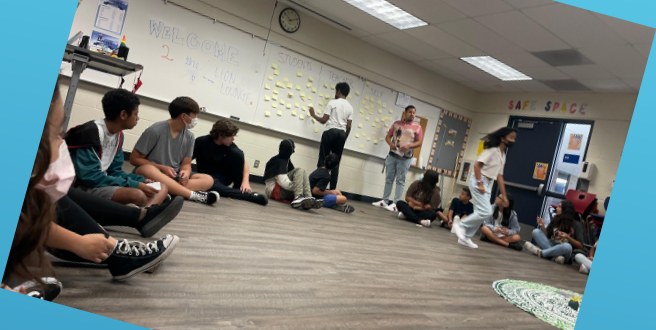

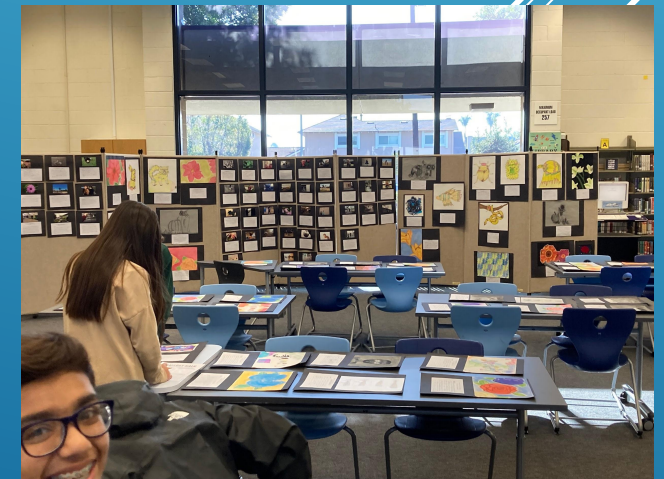

- ▶ Lion Lounge Restorative Justice through OC human relations

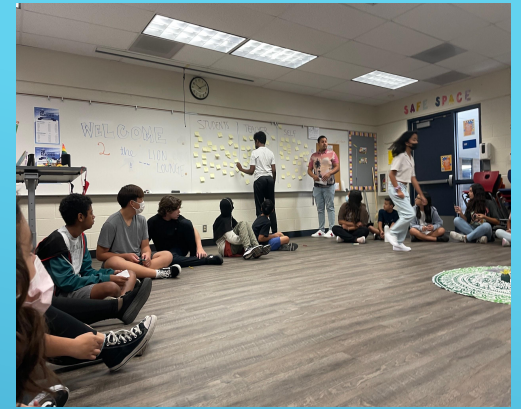


Lion Lounge
