STRATEGIES FOR SUCCESS



- Binder Reminder
 - Write down all homework for all classes on a daily basis
- Set up a homework routine

- Check Aeries at least once a week!
 - Parents **MUST** have an email address to gain access to Aeries



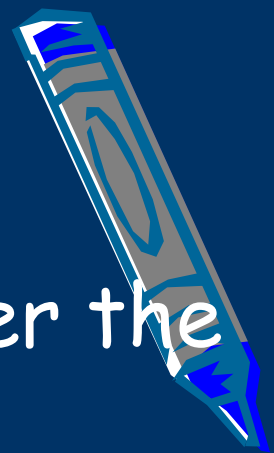
STRATEGIES FOR SUCCESS

- Be organized and get involved!



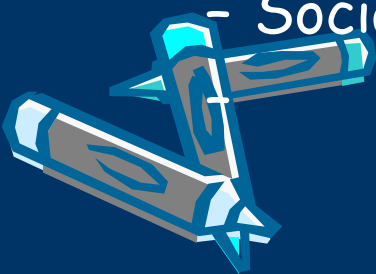
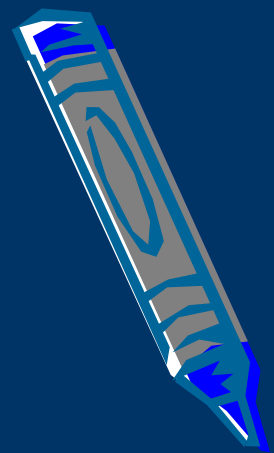
REGISTRATION PROCESS

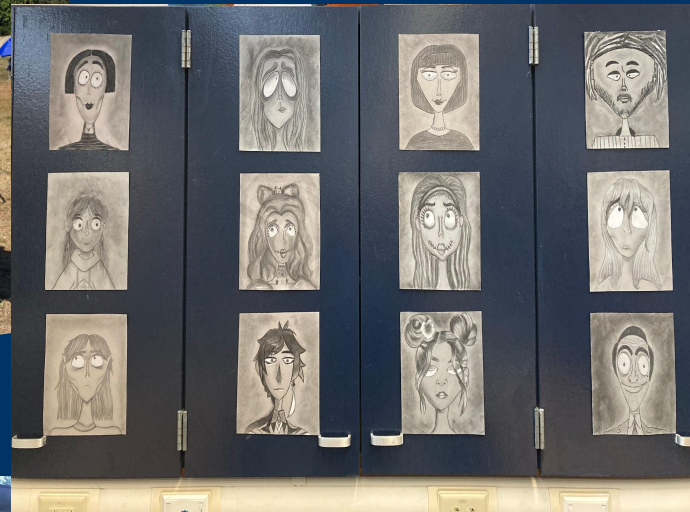
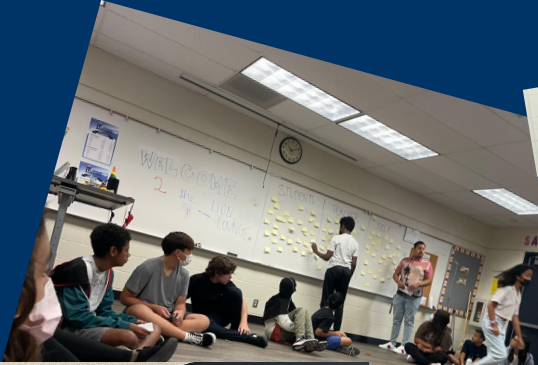
- *Aeries Communication / Parent Square*

 - Social school activities announcements

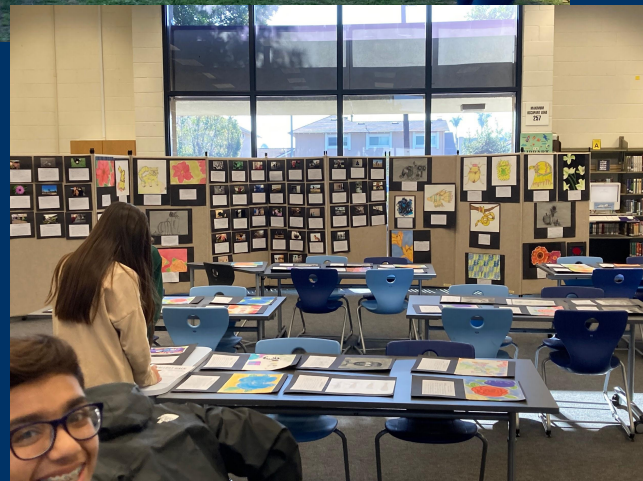

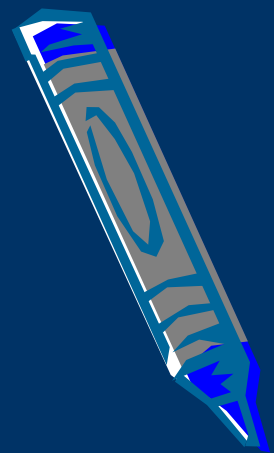

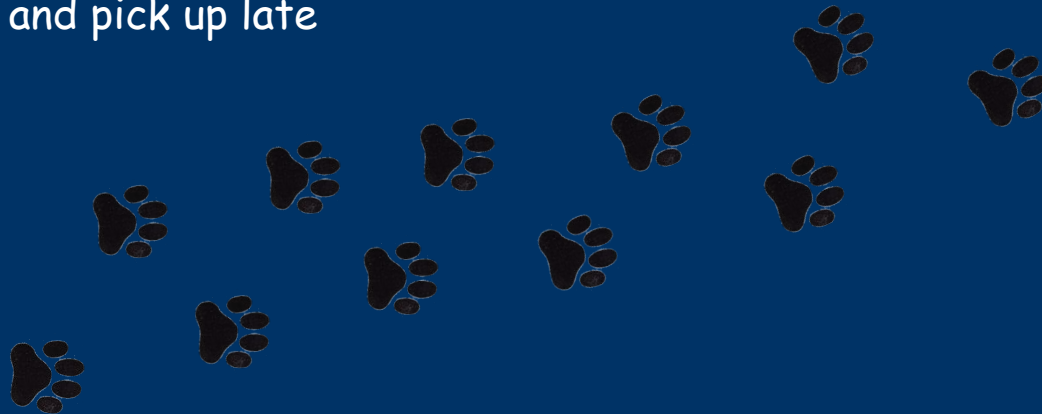


LEXINGTON'S PARKING LOT RULES AND TIPS



- The parking lot supports only one-way traffic
- When traveling west on Orange Ave., use the right entry lane ONLY
- When traveling east on Orange Ave., use the left entry lane ONLY
- Students may not be dropped off or picked up on Orange Ave.
- Students may only cross to the campus via crosswalks
- Cypress Police Dept. routinely monitors the Lexington parking lot

- Drop off and pick up in an alternate location i.e. behind the school, in the surrounding neighborhood
- Drop off early and pick up late

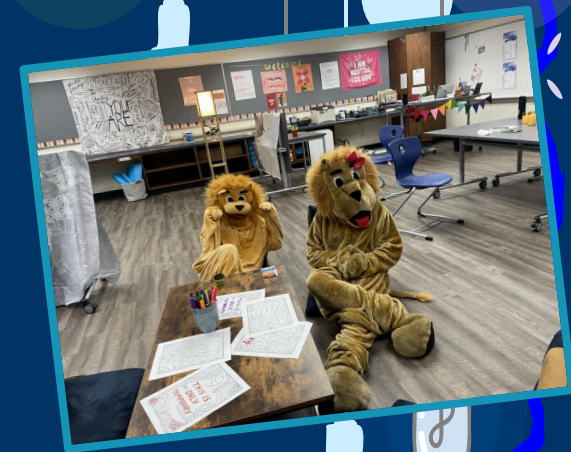


Restorative Justice on campus

Lion's Lounge

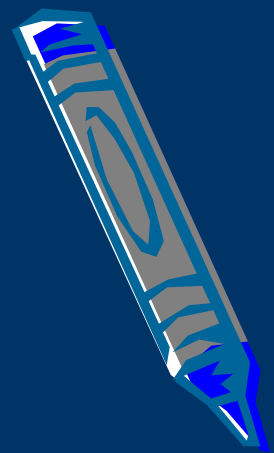
- Calm + Quiet space to decompress

PROGRESSIVE DISCIPLINE POLICY

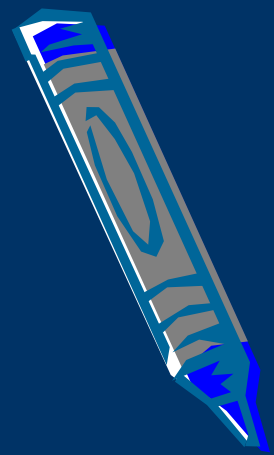

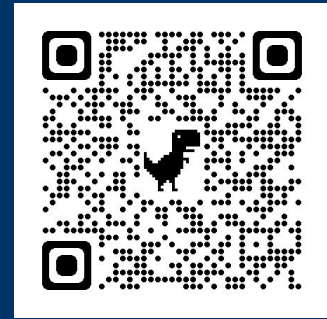
