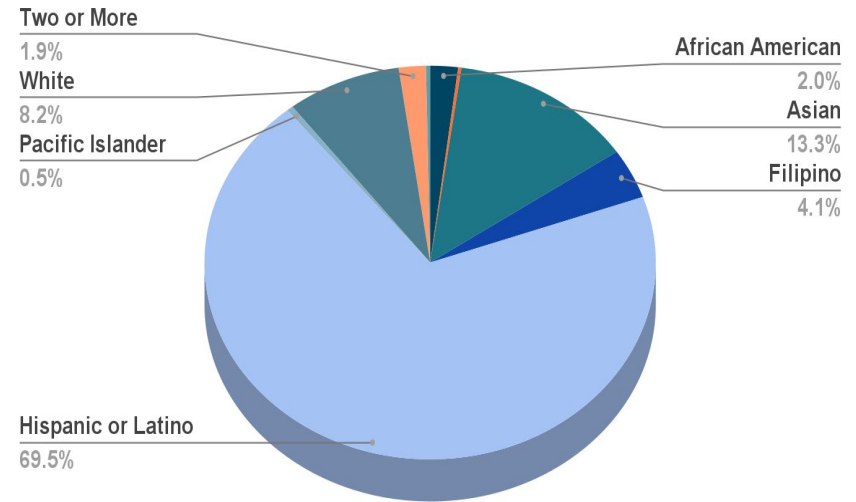

California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP)

English Language Arts/literacy (SBAC ELA): April 6 - 13

- One Performance Task (PT) +
One Computer Adaptive Test (CAT) = 3 hours est.

Mathematics (SBAC Math): April 17 - 21

- One Performance Task (PT) +
One Computer Adaptive Test (CAT) = 2.5 hours est.

California Science Test (CAST) 8th Grade Only: April 26 - 28

- One computer adaptive test (CAT) = 2 hours est.



Computer Adaptive Test (CAT) vs. Performance Task (PT)


CAT	PT
Adjusts level of difficulty to student's abilities.	Opportunity to demonstrate higher-order thinking skills to explore and analyze a complex, real-world scenario.
Student is scored on number of correct answers AND difficulty of questions completed.	Students will receive a score if not completed as long as they access both parts of the test.
